Practical information :

Within the **first 5 days**, you will learn how to build the **main structure** of the Kerterre (drain, foundation, straight wall, curved wall, isolating coat).

After the weekend, you will learn all the **finishing techniques** to make the Kerterre water-resistant (water-resistant coat, gutters).

A few weeks before the workshop starts, you will receive an e-mail from the instructor in which he/she will give you all the details about what to bring, how to find the place and who is coming in order to organize car-sharing.

The host will provide you with:

- ✓ A shower and toilets;
- ✓ A place to camp or accommodation;
- ✓ A place to cook;
- ✓ Lunch.

Protection gear to bring :

- ✓ Long and thick rubber gloves made for construction (+ under-gloves, like cleaning gloves) ;
- ✓ Protection glasses ;
- ✓ Anti-dust mask ;
- ✓ Working clothes (pants and long sleeves) ;
- ✓ Shoes that can get dirty (waterproof shoes or rubber boots if possible) ;
- ✓ Something to cover your hair (cap, hat, headscarf);
- ✓ Tent and sleeping-bag (depending on the place you'll be staying at) ;

This gear is compulsory in order to be part of the workshop.
